

Frequently Asked Questions

How does the waiting list work?

The waiting list is computerized and public. The date of hospitalization is communicated to the respective territorial District Asl.

What can I take with me the day of hospitalization?

Guests can be accompanied by a family member or a support Administrator.

- ✓ Personal effects (pyjamas, bath towel, a weeks' worth of comfortable clothes, essential products for personal hygiene)
- ✓ Health card
- ✓ A valid identification document for the guest and the accompanying family member
- ✓ If needed, the decree appointing the support Administrator / Guardian and a copy of his identification document
- ✓ Paper health record certifying exemptions
- ✓ Any pharmacological therapeutic plans
- ✓ Authorization certificate for entry into RSA or R1
- ✓ Any previous health documentation/record

PLEASE NOTE: The provisions regarding the management of visitor entrances inside residential facilities, as per the Circular of the Minister of Health provide information regarding safety for the guest, therefore Villa Mendicini apply the following rules: access for family members / relatives within the hospital units it is not allowed and, compatibly with the clinical conditions of the patient, visits will take place favouring the spaces outside the structure, "after pre-triage COVID-19" except for those with serious disabilities and non-self-sufficiency, for which it is possible, after consulting the responsible figures, to make video calls, booking them and agreeing on the time scheduled.

Receptions Hours

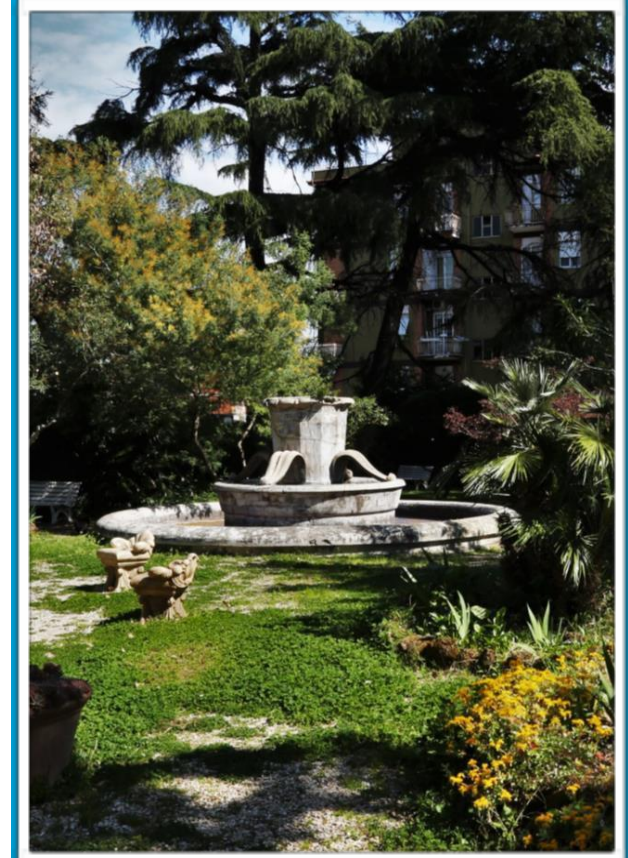
The doctors receive exclusively on Wednesday from 10.00 to 12.00 a.m. and from 4.00 to 6.00 p.m.

Our Services

Villa Mendicini is an affiliated healthcare facility, so every health service and the basic hotel services (meals and bedding) are guaranteed and free of charges.



- External service is guaranteed if there is no availability on the part of a care-giver.
- For the drugs service, delivery is guaranteed daily by Rellecati pharmacy in Piazza di Santa Maria in Trastevere No. 7

Additional paid services are:

- External service, even if a family contact is present but not available to perform it, the structure guarantees continuity, upon payment;
- External laundry service (collection and delivery twice a week): € 95 per month;
- The structure has an agreement with external professionals such as Podiatrist and hairdresser that offers their services at the request of the guest or family member;
- Secretarial fees for a copy of the Personal File (which can be collected 30 days after discharge on request): € 30 per copy;
- Analysis laboratory service, the payment is devolved to the operator who collects the blood sample ensuring the integrity of the sample, but not for the service as it is free;

Medical Practice

Stay wards RSA

Only patients with high-maintenance care needs can be admitted to the facility, the ward can accommodate a maximum of 20 beds. We provide in-patient services and social and health assistance services to those who cannot be treated at home. The services offered are structured to meet the needs and particularities of our guests. Our facility has daily medical assistance; and round-the-clock nursing. Physiotherapy is performed every day, guests will be treated according to rehabilitation needs, with particular attention to occupational therapy, art therapy, psychomotor and recreational activities as rehabilitation tools. We also have a nutritionist, a psychologist and the presence of a social worker, all necessary for the support of the guest and their family members.

For inclusion in the RSA

It is necessary to produce:

The referral from the attending physician, and to deliver it to the CAD of residence;

Visit of the Geriatric Evaluation Unit which certifies the level of care;

Waiting list for subsequent insertion into the facility.

The fee is to be paid as follows: guests who have an annual income from I.S.E.E. for an amount not exceeding € 20,000 are entitled to the municipal contribution., if different the structure invoices the health fee to the ASL and the membership fee to the user.



The Intensive Ward R1

The Intensive Rehabilitation Unit welcomes patients in a vegetative or minimally conscious state, ALS or other neurodegenerative syndromes in an advanced stage with high care complexity, coming from departments such as: Reanimation, Neurosurgery or Neurorehabilitation. The access proposal for the Intensive Residential Care Unit is carried out, alternatively, by the doctor of the resuscitation hospital unit with transfer until the COVID19 emergency ends, by the general practitioner or by the local services of the ASL and sent to the Evaluation Unit of the ASL of residence. A Certificate of authorization to enter R1 will be issued, to be delivered to the ASL offices of the District of residence. The ward has single and double rooms, with medical coverage h/24, the specialists present are varied and structured to the needs of the guests, such as Anaesthetist, Pulmonologist, Psychiatrist, Neurologist. Dedicated assistance trained by nurses and socio-health workers. It's also provided the presence of a physiotherapist with rehabilitation nursing activities, of a nutritionist and a psychologist.

Extensive treatment department D.C.C.G

Intended for people suffering from Alzheimer's syndrome or other forms of dementia with the need for high health protection, in the phases in which the pathologies are associated with behavioural disorders, the treatments are aimed at reorientation. The department has 12 beds equipped with all hotel comforts. The rooms are all double. For the modalities of entry to the department they are the same as the RSA.

Extensive treatment department

Intended for non self-sufficient people, with the need for high health protection, the main objective of the course is the identification and administration of temporary care in order to favour the improvement of clinical assistance conditions and the quality of life while waiting for access to new form of treatment. The ward consists of 20 beds. The rehabilitation team is made up of: rehabilitation therapists, professional educator, speech therapist, psychologist, social worker, ward doctors, nurses and social health worker.
